- The strategy to **promote investment and private sector growth** will not only be towards economic growth but will also promote job creation and business opportunities.

- Self-employment will be promoted and valued.



- Government will enhance the **School Feeding Programme** as a solution for keeping vulnerable children in school and improving their learning outcomes.



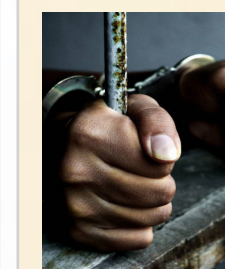

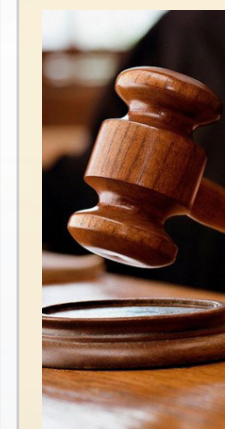


GOOD GOVERNANCE AND INTEGRITY

- Remain firm against unethical conduct in both public and private lives.

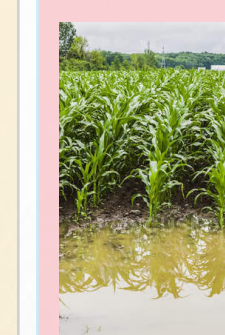


- Access to Justice will be assured and **devolution resident judgship to the provinces in an effort to bring justice closer to the people.**

- Mechanism for public financial management and procurement - **goods, services and works at the correct price, right quality and timely delivery.** Leakages will be sealed in procurement in the public sector.

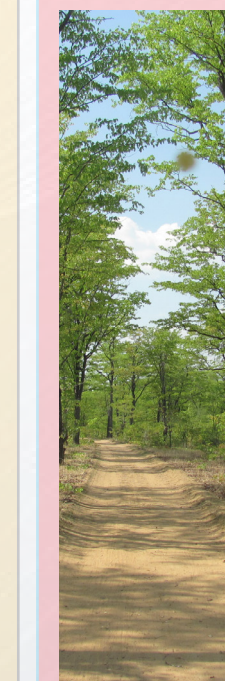


SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

- To further mitigate against the effects of climate change, Government is **promoting afforestation with 5,854.7 hectares of trees already planted.**
